80th Anniversary of the founding of our Order 30th General Chapter

For the 80th anniversary of the founding of the Order of the Knights of Our Lady, the General Chapter of its traditional observance based on its pre-Vatican II Rule, namely the Observance of the Holy Hearts of Jesus and Mary; was held simultaneously – and partially via video conference – in Prague, under the guidance of its Bishop-Protector His Excellency Monsignor Michal Stobnicki, and at the Seminary of the Heart of Jesus and Mary in Cebu, Philippines. In Prague, eight nationalities were represented: Australia, Bohemia-Moravia, Colombia, Egypt, France, Great Britain, Iraq, and Poland.

On this occasion, the Order was consecrated to the Child Jesus, both to the Holy Child Jesus of Prague in Prague and to the Señor Santo Niño of Cebu, in Cebu, presented by Magellan in 1521. It was by kneeling before almighty God, who became a little child out of love for us humans, that we gave thanks to him for 80 years of blessings, which did not spare us from struggles and trials, as befits knights on a battlefield strewn with pitfalls: death, injury, traitors and false brothers are part of the struggle, as Saint Paul said. And this is not the exception, but the norm.¹

¹ On this matter, we must caution, not only about the Order, which has become Conciliar, but also against a couple of bogus orders that have been set up, sometimes unfortunately on the initiative or with the support of priests, notably an Order of the Knights of Our Lady of the Assumption in France (2 members), another Order in Florida (3 knights) and still another completely illegitimate one, politically tied to Civitas-Media-Press-Info, mainly in France (around 40 members).
